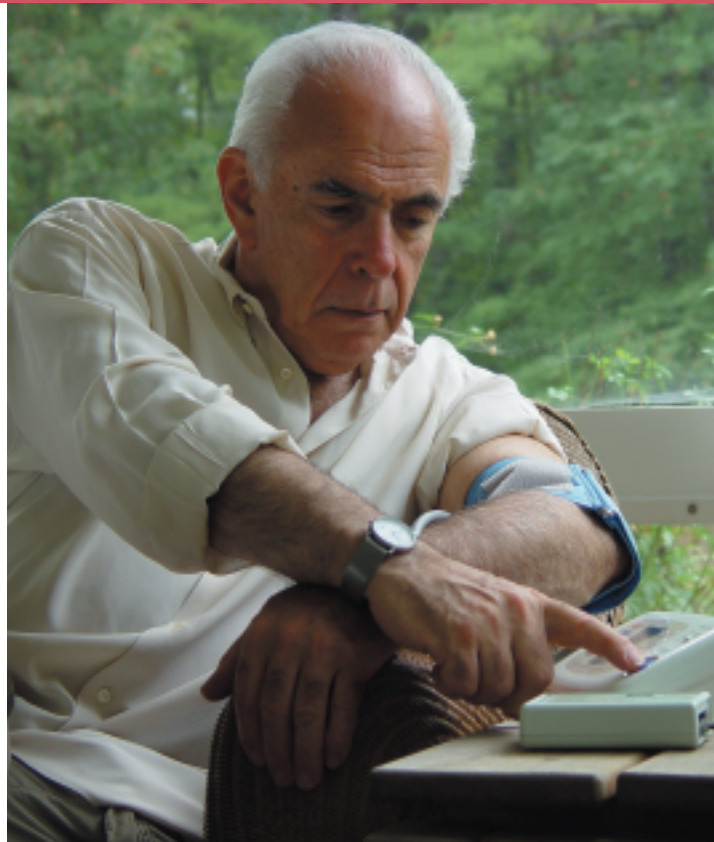

The CareVital monitoring system enables you to send your vital sign readings from the comfort of your own home without the need for an extra home nurse visit or a trip to the doctor's office. The CareVital unit is plugged into a phone line and sends vital sign data toll-free from your home directly to a secure website. Physicians, nurses and other healthcare professionals can check this site 24 hours a day and monitor your vital signs. All you have to do is take your readings and answer a few simple questions over the telephone about how you are feeling.

Benefits to the Patient

Sending your vital signs from the privacy of your own home helps you to remain independent and gives you an active role in your own healthcare management. You and your family members can rest assured knowing that your healthcare professionals have 24-hour access to your transmitted vital sign readings. If you are not feeling well at a time other than your normal monitoring time, you can send your vital signs again and ask your health care professionals to review them.

Studies have shown that using CareVital can reduce hospital readmissions for congestive heart failure patients by up to 83% in the first 30 days after their initial release from the hospital.

Accurate Results

CareVital provides accurate readings at the touch of a button. Doctors recommend that measurements be taken around the same time each day. Additionally, similar clothes should be worn and similar eating habits should occur before you weigh yourself.

After you have sent your vital signs, you will answer questions over the telephone. These questions give the healthcare professionals more information about your health and make better healthcare treatment possible.

Professional Review

Through a secure website, your physician, nurse and other healthcare professionals can review your transmitted vital signs 24-hours a day, 7 days a week.

With your permission, family members and other caregivers can also log onto the secure website to view your transmitted vital signs. This enables your family to be more active and supportive in your care at home.

Professional Installation

A certified installer will hook up the CareVital unit in your home, connecting it to a standard telephone line, and ensure that it is working properly. He or she will also explain the system to you and your family and answer any questions.
